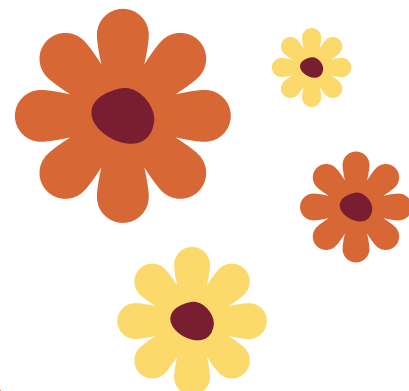

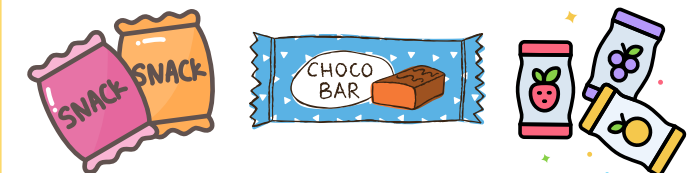


MAY BOARD HIGHLIGHTS

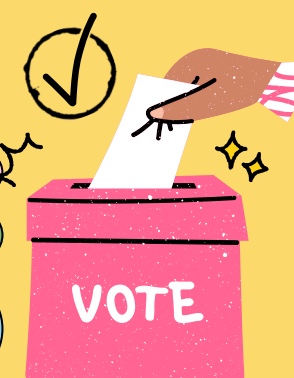
